Home Meridian International to Consolidate Key Divisions into High Point **The company has begun recruitment efforts to fill numerous positions**

(HIGH POINT, NC) – After selecting High Point for its new international headquarters last year, Home Meridian International announced today that it will bring several important departments, which currently operate in Phoenix and Pulaski, VA, to their new offices here. The company said the consolidation will create about 40 new positions and it has begun recruitment efforts.
